Construction Inspection Fees

Applicants for water and/or sanitary sewer main extensions are required to fully reimburse the District for all costs incurred as a result of the review of construction plans and specifications, and inspection of facility construction.

- **Reimbursement** shall be in the form of a pre-paid deposit based on the District's per foot plan review and construction inspection fee schedule and the footage of water and sewer mains installed.
- **Actual costs** are reconciled against the initial deposit each month and if the deposit will not be sufficient to complete the process, and additional deposit will be required.
- **At the Conclusion** of plan review and construction activities each account is reconciled and an invoice is submitted for costs not previously reimbursed, or remaining funds are returned to the applicant.
